After CD, with vet or doctor's certificate, less \$20 administration fee. Negative Coggins Test not required. All entries must include a photocopy of HTNB & NBEA memberships. Cheques made payable to Lori Leach.

2) TIME SCHEDULE: Aug. 23, 5:00pm course open/course walk; Aug. 24 8:00am – Dressage; 12:00 noon - Cross Country, Stadium to follow Cross Country. Start times available online Aug. 22 at www.braefearann.com.

4) STABLING: Limited stabling on grounds. Limited stabling also available approx. 5 km from Event. **\$30/day stabling fee must be pre-paid by August 15 to hold stall. Bring stall guards.**

5) DRESSAGE: OT –Training Test C-60; OPT - P-T Test C; OE - E Test B. Arena: T - 20 X 60m; PT & E - 20 x 40m; sand footing.

6) CROSS COUNTRY: T - 2400m @ 450mpm; PT - 2000m @ 400mpm; E - 1400m @ 355mpm. Terrain: New courses at all levels for 2008 with a wide variety of inviting and challenging x-c jumps. Excellent footing on rolling hay fields. **See website for course viewing.**

7) AWARDS: Ribbons to 5th. Various prizes awarded.
